The Board and Superintendent Santora reviewed the progress of the new Police Department Headquarters. The project continues to be progressing for a 2024 opening. The Board discussed the sale of 1 Britton Circle. A request for proposal will be issued in early January. At 9:00 p.m. Superintendent Santora was excused from Work Session.
