

European Hornbeam



The European Hornbeam is an attractive densely branched tree with distinctive dark green foliage that turns to warm yellow-orange in the fall, adding a touch of seasonal brilliance. In its youth, it grows in columnar form that breaks into an oval-vase based shape as the tree matures. Known for its versatility, the European Hornbeam can be pruned to create a formal hedge or left to grow as a majestic specimen tree. Due to its dense growth habit, it is often selected to provide shade or planted in groups as a screen or windbreak. Well-suited for in narrow yards or street-side planting.
