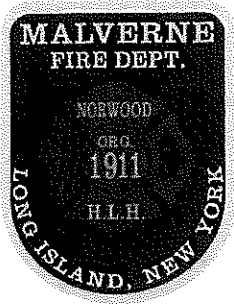

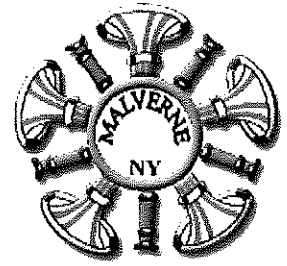

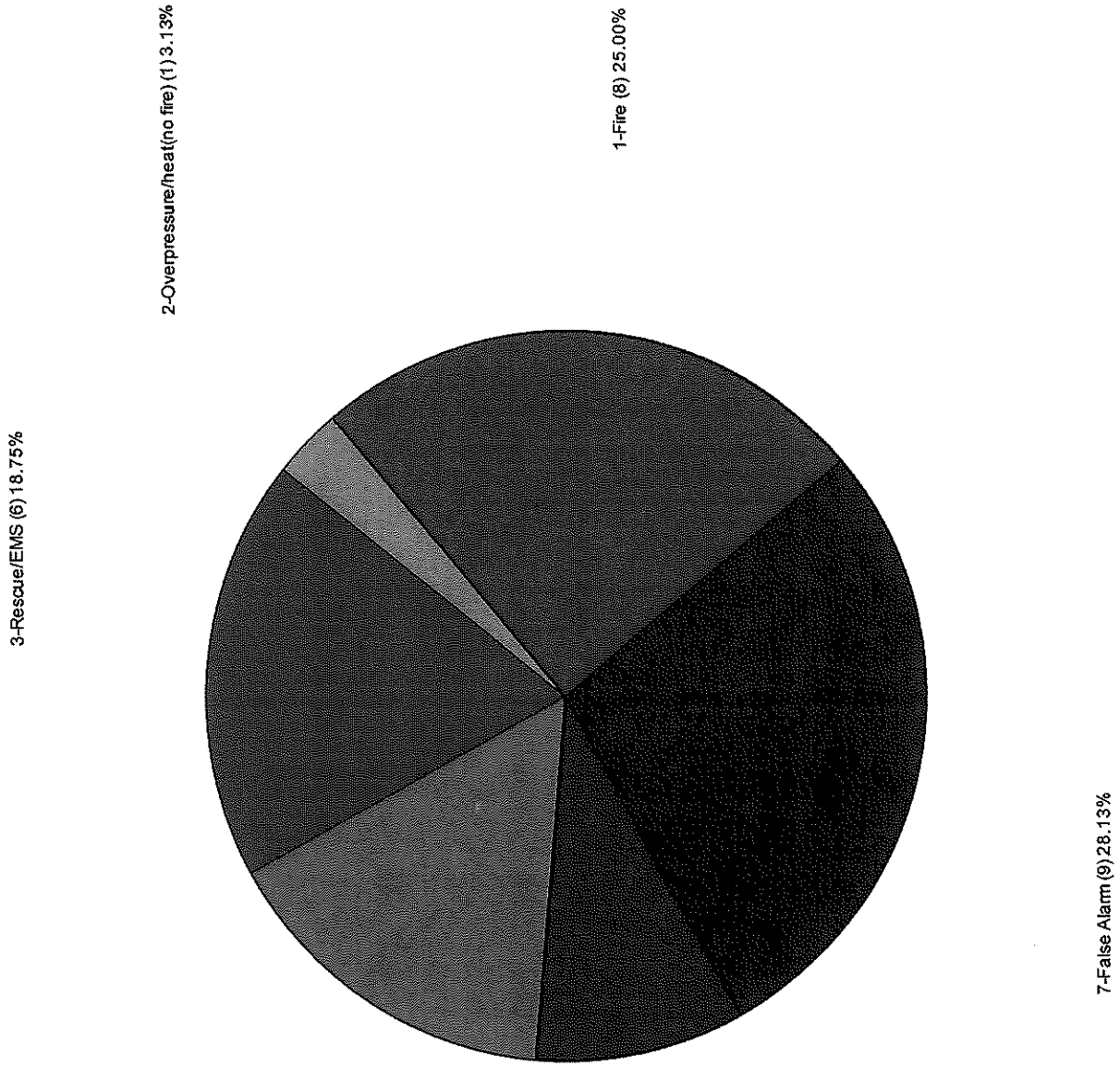

Malverne Fire Department

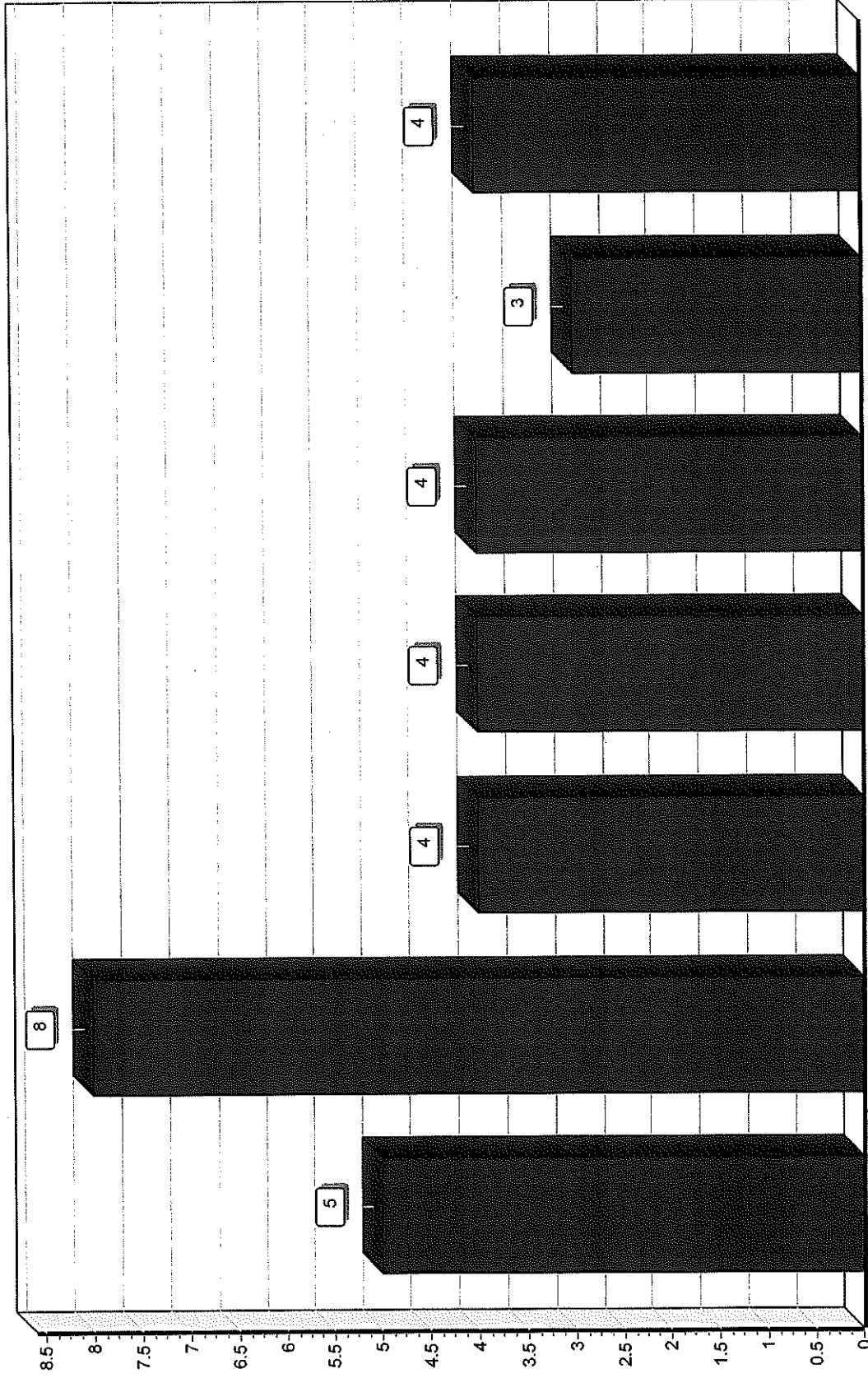
Date Range: From 01/01/2024 to 01/31/2024

Alarms by Day of Week

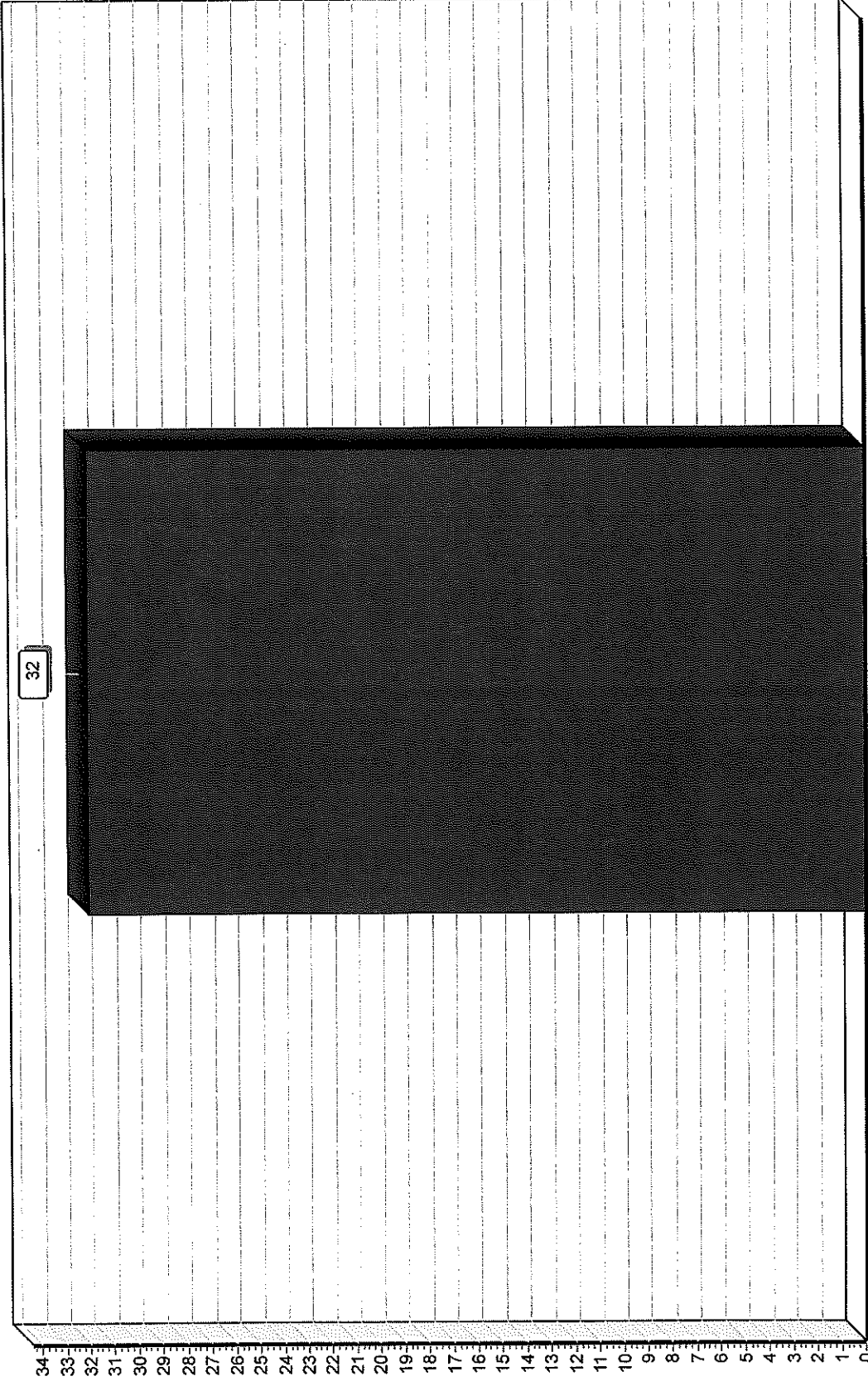
