SANITATION REGULATIONS

**Garbage is collected from the curb twice a week beginning at 7:00 am
Recyclables are collected once a week**

Please do not call for bulk pickups – appointments are NOT necessary		

Non-Metal Bulk Items: Collected on your **second garbage day (Thursday or Friday)**. There is a **limit of six (6) bulk items per household each week**. Please bundle loose items together when possible. Furniture does not need to be broken up. Tie wood in bundles not to exceed 2 feet in diameter and 4 feet in length with any nails removed or hammered down. Roll and tie rugs in bundles not to exceed 2 feet in diameter and 6 feet in length.

Freon Items (Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers): Picked up **Wednesdays**. *Refrigerator/freezer doors must be removed.*

Contractor Debris: Contractors **MUST** dispose of all building/landscaping debris. The Village is **not** responsible for disposal of refuse from tradesmen.

Newspapers: Must be tied or placed in a separate container or brown paper bag. They will **NOT** be collected if they are in plastic bags. (**No magazines, junk mail or books please**)

Cardboard: Boxes, cartons, etc. **must be flattened and securely tied or placed in a recycling bin**. Cardboard from food items should **NOT** be recycled.

Yard Waste: Collected year-round - Grass cuttings, leaves, brush, branches, tree and bush clippings can be placed in garbage pails, plastic bags or tied securely in bundles that are not to exceed 4 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter. Thorn bushes must be wrapped and tied to avoid injury to Village employees. **Real Christmas trees are collected as yard waste.**

Glass panes: To prevent injury to Village employees, **glass panes must be "X" taped, wrapped in newspaper or brown paper and marked with the word "Glass"**. Please do not use plastic bags when disposing of glass. Windows should be placed at the curb on your second collection day.

***Electronic Items:** New York State now requires the recycling of electronic equipment. Examples include TVs, computers, keyboards, monitors, faxes, VCRs & DVRs. Place these items at the curb on your recycling day beside your recycling bucket.

RECEPTACLES: Garbage should be placed in standard garbage containers **no larger than 32 gallons**. Each container must have handles and tight-fitting covers. **Covers cannot be attached to the cans**. **Garbage should not exceed 40 pounds**. Plastic bags may be used, however, they must be tied and not overfilled as they will tear.

RECYCLING TIPS (cans, bottles, plastics, newspapers and cardboard)

DO wash out food and liquids from all containers

DO separate newspapers and cardboard from plastic, cans & glass recyclables

DO compress items when possible

DO place your recycling bin next to your regular garbage container

DO check your plastic containers for their recycling number located in a triangle.

Our recycling program only accepts plastics numbered 1 & 2. If the number is higher or if there is no number marked on the container, please dispose of it with your regular garbage

DO flatten & tie cardboard boxes before placing at curb to prevent them from blowing away

DON'T mix garbage with your recyclables

DON'T place empty egg cartons or wax milk/juice containers in with your recyclables. Plastic milk/juice containers are accepted

DON'T put your newspapers in plastic shopping bags; newspapers in brown paper bags will be accepted

DON'T break glass before putting in bin

DON'T put light bulbs, ceramic glass, mirrors, items made of clay, chemical or oil containers, or laminated glass with recyclables

DON'T put aerosol cans (even empty ones) in with recyclables

Village ordinance prohibits placing garbage receptacles or rubbish at the curb prior to sunset on the day before pick up. All containers must be removed from the curb within twelve (12) hours after collection.

Standard 18-gallon recycling bins with Village of Malverne logos are available for purchase at the Village Hall during regular business hours
